Race 6

Following the running of the race there were two jockey objections. Javier Matias, the rider of the second place finisher, #1 Solemnly Swear, lodged an objection against the winner, #2 Mister Breeze, ridden by Juan Gutierrez, alleging interference around the turn. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the stewards determined that in the first incident #1 Solemnly Swear, did check briefly in the turn but the films were inconclusive as to any interference that took place, therefore the objection was disallowed. In the second objection, the rider of the sixth place finisher, Eliska Kubinova aboard #6 Delineator Express, lodged an objection against the fourth place

finisher, #4 Roman Boos, ridden by Natasha Coddington, alleging interference in the stretch. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the stewards determined that #5 He's Cagey, who finished seventh and was ridden by Erick Lopez, stepped out slightly near the eighth pole, while the #4 horse stepped in slightly at the same point, causing the rider of the #6 horse to check, but there was always running room between the two horses, therefore the objection was disallowed. The final order of finish remained 2-1-3-4-8-6-5-7.
