After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the board of stewards determined that #6 Vistarella, did drift out slightly down the lane into the path of #5 Gracie Gold, who was looking for clear racing room. Both riders corrected their course and the board of stewards determined that the marginal interference did not cost #5 Gracie Gold, the opportunity of a better placing, therefore no change was made to the official order of finish.

A conference notice was issued to apprentice jockey David Martin to review the videos with the board of stewards for failing to ride his horse to the wire.
