Emerald Downs Race Meet

Report for Sunday, June 18, 2017

Track Condition: Fast

A stewards' ruling conference was held with jockey Juan Gutierrez for an incident that occurred late in the stretch in the fifth race on June 17th, 2017. After hearing testimony and reviewing the video of the race, the stewards determined that Mr. Gutierrez allowed his horse to veer in causing interference to an inside horse. Mr. Gutierrez was fined \$200.00 for careless riding. Ruling number EMD17-073.

A ruling conference was held with jockey Leonel Camacho Flores at which time testimony was heard and a review of the video was conducted. Mr. Camacho Flores was assessed a fine of \$250.00 for misuse of the riding crop in the first race on Friday, June 16, 2017. Ruling number EMD17-074.

Race 7

Following the running of the race, Howard Belvoir, the trainer of #4 Barkley, who finished fourth and was ridden by Javier Matias, lodged an objection against #6 Mach One Rules, who finished first and was ridden by Isaias Enriquez alleging interference down the lane. After reviewing the videos of the race and taking the testimony of the riders involved the board of stewards determined that #6 Mach One Rules was always clear of #4 Barkley who changed course while looking for running room, therefore the decision of the board of stewards was to make no change to the original order of finish.

Race 10

Following the running of the race, Kevin Orozco, the rider of #7 Myt Fine, lodged an objection against #4 Betting On Dr Bow, ridden by J.C. Estrada, alleging interference down the stretch. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the stewards determined that in late stretch #4 Betting On Dr Bow did drift out making contact with #7 Myt Fine, however, the stewards ruled that the interference did not cost #7 Myt Fine the opportunity of a better placing and made no change to the original order of finish. A stewards conference notice was issued to jockey J.C. Estrada to appear before the board of stewards for a film review.
