Race 2

Following the running of the race, Eswan Flores, the rider of #2 Hemi Cat, lodged an objection against #5 Crystal Mtn Stormy, ridden by Juan Gutierrez, alleging interference near the finish line. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved, the board of stewards determined that near the wire #5 Crystal Mtn Stormy drifted in slightly, however #2 Hemi Cat always had racing room and the rider overreacted and it did not cost #2 Hemi Cat the opportunity of a better placing. The board of stewards made no change to the original order of finish.

Race 3

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry due to an incident at the break involving #3 Parker's Prince, whose rider Leonel Camacho Flores was unseated at the start. After reviewing the videos, the stewards determined that #3 Parker's Prince stumbled on its own accord and lost its rider and therefore made no change to the order of finish.

Race 7

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry due to an incident shortly after the start involving #1 Carl Command, whose rider Leonel Camacho Flores was unseated soon after the start. After reviewing the videos, the stewards determined that #1 Carl Command ducked in sharply on its own accord and lost its rider and therefore made no change to the order of finish.
