Race 1

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident at the top of the stretch involving the fourth place finisher #2 Parkers Rose, ridden by Jose Zunino, and the sixth place finisher #5 Blushing Ann, ridden by Gary Wales. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the stewards determined that at the top of the stretch #2 Parkers Rose angled in sharply causing #5 Blushing Ann to check and clip heels. The decision of the board of stewards was that the interference did not cost #5 Blushing Ann the opportunity of a better placing therefore no change was made to the original order of finish. The original order of finish was not changed, 6-4-3-2-1-5. A conference notice was issued to jockey Jose Zunino to appear before the board of stewards for a film review.
