Race 1

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to two separate incidents. The first incident occurred near the 7/16ths pole involving #6 Im Insatiable Too, ridden by Lorenzo Lopez. The stewards determined #6 Im Insatiable Too fell of her own accord while trailing the field near the 7/16th pole, thus no other horse was at fault. The second incident occurred at the head of the stretch involving the first place finisher #5 Sweet Swindler, ridden by Rocco Bowen, and fourth place finisher #1 Royal Guard, ridden by Eswan Flores. The stewards determined that at the head of the stretch #1 Royal Guard bore out of his own accord and continued to bear out the length of the stretch, therefore no change was made to the official order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 5-2-4-1-3-(#6 Unplaced).

Race 2

Following the running of the race, Assistant Trainer Bonifacio Rayas representing third place finisher #3 Instinctual Kash, ridden by Gary Wales, lodged an objection against second place finisher #4 Dakota's Tango, ridden by Rocco Bowen, alleging interference at the start of the race. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that #4 Dakota's Tango did break in slightly making contact with #3 Instinctual Kash, however the contact did not cost #3 Instinctual Kash a better finish position, therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 2-4-3-1-5-6.
