Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign to look into two incidents in the stretch run of the race and there were two jockey objections. Austin Solis, the rider of third place finisher #2 Hello Bourbon, lodged an objection against second place finisher #5 Thereis Thatharbor, ridden by Patrick Henry Jr. alleging interference in the stretch and Patrick Henry, Jr., the rider of the second place finisher #5 Theris Thatharbor lodged an objection against the winner #4 He' Not Grey ridden by Erick Lopez, also alleging interference in the stretch. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that in the first objection #2 Hello Bourbon did check briefly in late stretch but he always had racing room, therefore the objection was disallowed. In the second objection there was minor mutual contact at the head of the lane, therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 4-3-2-7-9-3-6-8-.
