**Race 4**

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident at the start of the race in which second place finisher #5 A Little Romance, ridden by Julien Couton, broke slowly and trailed the field. After reviewing the videos the stewards determined that prior to the break #5 A Little Romance began to rear up just as the front doors were opening, however, the starting gate of #5 A Little Romance opened in unison with the rest of the field and the assistant starter released the horse properly. The horse was given the opportunity of a fair start and therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 6-5-4-2-3-7-1-(8-DNF).

**Race 4**

A claim by trainer Bill Tollett for #8 Emerald Candy was voided per WAC 260-60-460 (2.a.). Emerald Candy suffered a catastrophic injury just past the 3/8ths pole and was euthanized.

**Race 6**

Following the running of the race, Alex Anaya, the rider of fifth place finisher #4 Indian Power, lodged an objection against second place finisher #6 Lovethisbar, ridden by Francisco Orduna-Rojas, alleging interference down the backstretch. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that #4 Indian Power was in between horses in tight quarters nearing the seven sixteenths pole, however there was insufficient interference to warrant a disqualification and

#4 Indian Power was not denied the opportunity of a better placing, therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 8-6-5-1-4-7-3.
