Emerald Downs Race Meet

Report for Friday, May 18, 2018
Track Condition: Fast

On Saturday, May 5, 2018, a ruling conference was held with jockey Jose L. Zunino at which time testimony was heard and a review of the videos was conducted. The jockey license of Mr. Zunino was suspended three racing days, Saturday, May 12, 2018, Sunday, May 13, 2018, and Friday, May 18, 2018, for careless riding while aboard #2 Parkers Rose in the first race on April 29, 2018, causing interference to another horse. On Monday, May 7, 2018, Jose L. Zunino filed an appeal to ruling number EMD18-014 and was granted a stay of his suspension. On Thursday, May 17, 2018, Mr. Zunino dropped his appeal. Therefore, Mr. Zunino was suspended three racing days, Friday, May 25, 2018, Saturday, May 26, 2018, and Sunday, May 27, 2018, for careless riding while aboard #2 Parkers Rose in the first race on April 29, 2018, causing interference to another horse. This was amended and addressed in ruling number EMD18-023.

A ruling conference was held with jockey Julien Couton regarding his failure to ride his mount #1 'Atta Boy Dougie' to the finish in the first race on Sunday, May 13, 2018. Testimony was heard and a review of the video was conducted. The stewards determined that Mr. Couton had stood up on his horse before the finish line and the race resulted in his horse being beaten in a close photo for second. Mr. Couton is assessed a fine of \$250.00 for failing to ride his horse to the finish. This was addressed in ruling number EMD18-024.
