After reviewing the videos the stewards determined that prior to the break #7 So Lucky threw his head up and stepped back as the front doors were opening, however, the starting gate of #7 So Lucky

opened in unison with the rest of the field and the assistant starter released the horse properly. The horse was given the opportunity of a fair start and therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 2-1-5-4-6-7.
