Race 4

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident in late stretch and Michael Puhich, the trainer of fourth place finisher #12 Motion Emotion, ridden by Kevin Orozco, lodged an objection against first place finisher #10 Mr. Frank, ridden by Javier Matias, alleging interference down the stretch. The inquiry also involved second place finisher #11 Rally Cat, ridden by Julien Couton. After reviewing the videos of the race and taking testimony from the riders involved the stewards determined that #10 Mr. Frank drifted out slightly causing #12 Motion Emotion to alter course between #10 Mr. Frank and #11 Rally Cat, however it did not cost #12 Motion Emotion a better placing therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 10-11-1-12-3-2-6-4-8-9.

Race 6

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident at the start of the race in which ninth place finisher #4 Mykx Bull, ridden by Leonel Camacho-Flores, broke slowly and trailed the field. After reviewing the videos the stewards determined that at the break #4 Mykx Bull broke awkwardly, getting Mr. Camacho off balance at which time he lost both his stirrups and did not attempt to recover either one. However, the starting gate of #4 Mykx Bull opened in unison with the rest of the field and the assistant starter released the horse properly. The horse was given the opportunity of a fair start and therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 1-10-2-7-8-9-6-4.
