Race 2

Following the running of the race Alex Cruz, the rider of #4 Coastal Wonder claimed foul against #3 Larsen Bay and his rider Jennifer Whitaker for interference in the vicinity of the quarter pole. After speaking to both riders and reviewing the video replays it could not be determined with certainty that a foul had occurred, due to the location on the track and available video coverage and the erratic behavior of the #4 prior to the incident. Furthermore #4 was beaten 13 lengths and as such, even if a foul had occurred it did not cost him the chance of a better placing. The original order of finish was then declared official. A conference notice was prepared for Ms. Whitaker.

Race 3

Immediately following the running of the race the inquiry sign was hung to look into an incident going into the turn involving the eventual first and second place finishers, #3 Judicial and his rider Julien Couton and #1 Sigrid's Gold and his rider Jose Zunino. During a contentious call to the winners circle in which we spoke to both riders and reviewing the replays, it was determined that while #1 was in very tight quarters, due to indecision the rider put himself in no man's land at the point of the turn and was forced to take out of what could have been his position. As such, no change was warranted and the

original order of finish was declared official. Conference notices were prepared for both Mr. Couton and Mr. Zunino.
