Race 5

Following the running of the race, Ryan Barber the rider of second place finisher #3 "Front Row Friends", lodged an objection against first place finisher #1 "Crest Drive", ridden by Gary Wales, alleging interference shortly after leaving the starting gate. The inquiry sign was also posted while the horses were galloping out. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that while #1 did come out shortly after the start, #2 "I Came To Play" had come out, and #4 "Aggravate" came in causing #3 to begin to check, shortly after this the #1 came out. The stewards decision was that due to the distances they were beaten by, #2 "I Came To Play", #3 "Front Row Friends" and #4 "Aggravate" did not cost the opportunity of a better placing, therefore the stewards did not make any change to the original order of finish. The official order of finish is as follows: 1-3-2-8-5-4-7.

Race 8

Following the running of the race, Kay Cooper the trainer of fourth place finisher #8 "Turntheclocktozero" ridden by Kevin Krigger lodged an objection against third place finisher #2 "Wilson To Lockett", ridden by Ryan Barber, alleging interference down the lane. The inquiry sign was also posted. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that near the head of the lane #8 came out bumping #2 several times, and #2 came in to make contact several times with the #8, the contact was deemed mutual, therefore and no change was made to the original order of finish of 1-3-2-8-4-7-5-9-10-6 and it was made official.
