**Race 2**

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident at the start of the race. It was determined that the involved parties were the second place finisher #6 John Carter Cash, ridden by Leonardo Gonzalez, and the fifth place finisher #5 One Flyn Foose, ridden by Robert Burney and seventh place finisher #4 Sables Dashin ridden by Nakia Ramirez. Freddy Ibarra the trainer of #5 lodged an objection against the other two contestants as well. After reviewing the videos and taking the testimony of the riders involved the stewards determined that shortly after the start the #6 broke in while the #4 broke out meeting in the space that should have been occupied by the #5 horse, causing him to check and lose his running lane, and was cost the opportunity of a better placing. Therefore #6 was disqualified from second and placed fifth behind #5, while #4 was involved in the foul he was outran by the fouled horse and therefore was not involved in any demotion. The initial order of finish 7-6-3-8-5-6-2-4-1 was amended to 7-3-8-5-6-2-4-1 and made official. Conference notices were prepared for Mr. Gonzalez and Ms. Ramirez.
