Race 1 Stewards Review/ Inquiry/ No Change

Following the running of the race a steward's review was posted to review the running of the race, which was followed by an inquiry, involving #2 Good Candy Dash and #1 Corona Crystal JP & #5 The Weekend #6 Corona Wagon Train any incidents involving the four horses above was deemed mutual interference, and there was no change to the original order of finish.

Race 2 Riders Objection/ No Change

Following the running of the race a rider's objection was lodged by Jake Samuels the rider of #5 Check The Cartel against the #6 Cottonwood Blossom and his rider Jose Beltran for interference in the middle of the stretch. #6 Cottonwood Blossom who raced greenly but was clear of the #5 and as such no change was made the original order of finish.

Race 3 Trainers Objection/ No Change

Long after the running of race the trainer of #4 No Juans Fool, Sergio Leon lodged an objection against the #3 Super Bowl Sunny Day. #3 raced greenly but was clear of the #4, and as such no change was made to the original order of finish.

Race 6 Stewards Review/ No Change

Following the running of the race a steward's review was posted to look into an incident, involving #4 Aloha Breeze & #2 Ask Alice coming on to the main track, from the chute. It was determined the while the #4 did come over abruptly, this action did not cost the #2 a chance of a better placing, so there was no change to the original order of finish.
