Race 1

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident inside the sixteenth pole involving third place finisher #1 Code Charlie, ridden by Alex Anaya, fourth place finisher #3 Lasting Legend, ridden by Gary Wales, and unplaced runner #7 Racy Opinion, ridden by Franklin Ceballos who fell. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved, the stewards determined that inside the sixteenth pole, #1 Code Charlie came out bumping with #7 Racy Opinion who was between those two and in tight quarters after running greenly behind #3. #7 Racy Opinion was able to correct course to split #3 and #7 at which time #3 came in slightly bumping #7 causing them to tangle legs and fall. Therefore, the stewards disqualified #1 Code Charlie from third place and #3 Lasting Legend from fourth place and made them unplaced. The original order of finish of 6-4-1-3-5 was changed to 6-4-5.

Race 6

Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident involving #2 Informed Lady who fell in mid-lane. On the gallop out the rider of second place finisher #5 Windy Point, Juan Gutierrez claimed foul against the winner #10 For You Only and her rider Jennifer Whitaker for interference in the middle of the turn. It was first determined that the #2 broke down with no other horses in the vicinity. Additionally after reviewing multiple angles of replay and speaking to Mr. Gutierrez and Ms. Whitaker it was determined that Mr. Gutierrez's claim of foul not be allowed, as while it may have been tight, #5 always had racing room and was not cost the opportunity of a better placing, and as such no change was made in the order of finish and it was made official.
