Race 6 Stewards Review/No Change

Following the running of the race a steward's review was conducted to look into an incident in the vicinity of the 3/16 poles involving the unofficial third place finisher #8 Big City Bane and his rider Vladimir Jensen and unofficial winner #2 Rocky Tough and his rider Javier Matias. After reviewing the replays, it was determined that #8 came in on #2, however the #2 beat the fouling horse, and as such no change was made to the original order of finish and was declared official.

Race 7 Inquiry/Objection/No Change

Following the running of the race the trainer of unofficial third place finisher #1 Forty Smooches, Kay Cooper lodged an objection for interference shortly after the break, against the unofficial winner #2 Nine One One. After reviewing the replays and speaking to both riders involved, it was determined the while the two horses did brush and bump shortly after the break, the contact between the two did not cost the #1 the chance of a better placing. Accordingly, the objection sign was extinguished and the original order of finish was declared official.

Race 8 Inquiry/Objection/No Change

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was hung to look into multiple bumping incidents in the lane, involving the unofficial winner #4 You're The Cause and his rider Alex Cruz and unofficial second place finisher #7 Cause I'm Cool and his rider Heribert Martinez. After reviewing the replays and speaking to both riders involved it was determined that the first contact was caused by the #7, coming out to brush with #4 at the head of the lane, further contact was determined to be mutual or #7 appeared to be most at fault. Accordingly, the inquiry and objection signs were extinguished, and the original order of finish was declared official.
