Immediately following the running of the race the rider of the #3 horse Party For One, Alex Anaya claimed foul against the second place finisher #6 Shifty Dancer and his rider Heribert Martinez for alleged interference going into the first turn. After speaking to the riders of the #3,#5 & #6 and reviewing the replays, it was determined that it was last place finisher #5 Jackson Teller and his rider Javier Matias who applied the initial pressure to the horses on the inside, that the #6 followed the #5 down, and that #6 did relieve the pressure. The #5 finished last, so there was no need to make any change in the order of finish. The objection sign was extinguished and original order of finish was declared official.
