**Race 4 Rider Objection/No Change**

Following the running of the race the rider of #2 Youonlylivetwice, Chester Bonnet lodged an objection against #1 Eyes For Gold and his rider Jose Zunino for interference in the vicinity of the half-mile pole. Trainer Kay Cooper also called to possibly lodge an objection, we informed her that her Jockey had already lodged an objection, and as such she didn't need to object as well, she hung up satisfied that we were already looking into the incident. After speaking to the riders and reviewing the replays it was determined that #1 broke slowly, was rank and pulled his way into contention from last place between two horses and on heels of the #4 Paislees Pulpit, who was coming over gradually while attempting to clear the horses behind him. While we felt the movement of the #4 was forceful, it would not have been an issue if the #1 had rated while in tight quarters approaching the turn, with the #2 to his inside.

Both #1 and #2 needed to give way, however we felt that #2 was not cost the chance of a better placing, and the original order of finish was declared official.
