Following the running of the race, Assistant Trainer Dennis Snowden called to file a Trainer's objection on behalf of his horse #6 Aero Street, who ran sixth, against the winner #5 Fuzzy Dolphin, for interference at the break. After reviewing the replays and speaking to both riders, it was deemed that while #5 Fuzzy Dolphin did break out at the start making contact the first jump out of the gate, and that #6 Aero Street appeared to not be bothered that much from the contact and was not substantially hindered due to the interference. No change was made to the original order of finish and was declared official.
