LATE JOCKEY CHANGES: None

Race 1

Due to a late scratch, show wagering was removed from this race.

Race 3

Due to 2 late scratches, show wagering was removed from this race. Immediately following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was lit to look into contact between the first two unofficial finishers. After reviewing the replays, it was determined that the #4 caused the interference to #5. The inquiry sign was extinguished, no change was made to the original order of finish and declared official.

Race 8

Assistant starter George Colello will be the starter for this race. Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to look at an incident in the late stretch involving the #1 & #6. After reviewing the videos, it was determined the contact was mutual and no change was made.

Race 9

Immediately following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was lit to look into the start of the #4 "Dodropin" who was away very slowly/awkwardly. After reviewing the replays, it was determined that while the horse may have thrown his head at the start, the assistant starter failed to release control of the horse in a timely manner, as a result the #4 was declared a non-starter. There was a communication issue getting this information into the new tote system. Due to the timing involved, the order of finish, which included the #4 was incorrectly declared official. Tote corrected the error and recalculated the payoffs.
