**Race 6**

After receiving the claims from the claims clerk, it was discovered after the shake, that the winning claim made by trainer Jorge Rosales was invalid, as he is not authorized agent for the owner. As it was an agency error, the shake was redone, with the horse Dance Lady going to owner Purple Rose Ranch, and trainer M.L. Pierce.

### **Race 7**

Following the running of the race a Stewards review was conducted to look into the break of #1 & #5. While reviewing the break a trainers objection was lodged by Valentin "Picho" Garcia for alleged interference in the lane of #3 Stand To. Shortly after the review was escalated to an inquiry. After reviewing the replays of the objection, there was no change made to this order of finish. The board of stewards returned to the review/inquiry. It was determined that unofficial winner #5 You Split Tens and his rider Alex Cruz and unofficial second place finisher #1 Try To Capture and his rider Luis Negron, be disqualified and placed behind the #2 Hollywood As Usual for interference at the start, causing #2 the chance of a better placing. After attending to the review/inquiry, it appeared the tote board did not get properly lit to reflect the inclusion of the #1 and #5 in the inquiry, as a result the pending disqualification of the first 2 finishers was not properly presented, until the results were reposted, from **5-1-3-6-4-7-2** to **3-6-4-7-2-5-1** and declared official.
