**Race 7**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was lit, to look into an incident near the 3/8<sup>th</sup> pole possibly involving the unofficial winner #5 Lafonda and her jockey Javier Matias, unofficial fifth place finisher #2 Crazy About You and her rider Jose Zunino and unofficial third place finisher #1 Warren's Memorable and her jockey Alex Cruz. After reviewing the replays, it was determined that #5 was clear, and that #2 came over without proper clearance, causing #1 to check. However, the #1 finished ahead of the #2, and as such no change was made to the original order of finish. The inquiry was dropped and the original result of 5-6-1-7-2-4-3-8 was declared official.

### **Race 9**

Following the running of the race a rider's objection was lodged by the rider of #3 Nationheart, Kevin Radke against the #6 Hula King and his rider Kenneth Deonauth and the #9 Sierra Melody and his rider Silvio Amador for interference near the 3/8<sup>th</sup> pole. The stewards were already reviewing the replays related to this incident. After fully reviewing the replays, it was determined that #9 came over without proper clearance, fouling the #6 Hula King, #4 Foster Boi and #3 Nationheart. Accordingly, #9 Sierra Melody was disqualified from second place and placed eighth behind #3 Nationheart who was cost the chance of a better placing due to the foul. The original order of finish 2-9-7-4-6-1-5-3-8 was amended to 2-7-4-6-1-5-~~3~~-9-8 and declared official.
