Race 3 INQUIRY/ Disqualification

Immediately following the running of the race the inquiry sign was lit denoting the third & fourth place finishers. After speaking to both riders and reviewing the video replays it was determined that #3 The Lair came out at the head of the lane substantially knocking the #5 Barkley's Image off stride. The #5 continued to battle, being beat 1 ¼ lengths for third, and was therefore cost the chance of a better placing. After extinguishing the inquiry sign, the #5 was disqualified from third to fourth. The original order of finish 1-2-~~5~~-~~3~~-7-4-6 was amended to 1-2-~~3~~-~~5~~-7-4-6 and declared official.

Race 5 INQUIRY/ Trainers Objection/ No Change

Immediately following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was lit denoting the #1, #4 & #6 followed by a trainer's objection by the #6. After reviewing the video replays it was determined that while the #1 did come out slightly, and the #4 came in to bump #6, these actions did not cost the #6 the chance of a better placing. The inquiry and objection signs were extinguished, and the original order of finish declared official.

Race 7 INQUIRY/ RIDERS OBJECTION/ DISQUALIFICATION

Immediately following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was lit denoting the inquiry sign was hung denoting #3 & #2 the first and second place finishers for an incident in the lane. After speaking to both riders involved and reviewing the video replays, it was determined that the #3 lugged in causing the #2 to check, losing momentum, and then recovering to be beaten a very short nose. As a result, it was determined that the actions of the #2 cost the #3 the chance of a better placing, The inquiry and objections signs were extinguished and the original order of finish 2-3-6-4-1-5 was amended to 3-2-6-4-1-5 and declared official.
