### Race 1

Immediately following the running of the race the inquiry sign was hung to look into the break of the #3 Mischief Mama, who broke awkwardly, and was away far behind the field. After reviewing the replays and speaking to Starter Mark Gibson, it was determined that Mischief Mama was afforded the opportunity of a fair start and caused her own problems.

### Race 3

Immediately following the running of the race, the inquiry sign was hung to look into a possible incident involving the first two finishers #3 and #2. This was followed by an objection from the trainer of the #2. After reviewing the replays and speaking to both riders. It was determined that #2 always had room, was not cost chance of a better placing as he held 2<sup>nd</sup>, and the #3 was almost three lengths clear. The inquiry was not announced, only the objection. The signs were extinguished, and the original order of finish declared official.
